

Mid Hills Netball Association Carnival Committee

COACHES RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Behave in a responsible manner to ensure the Mid Hills Netball Association does not come into disrepute.
- 2. Coaches must be accredited. A coach must hold a current Development Accreditation or be prepared to complete the Foundation and Development course within 12 months of coaching appointment, where possible.
- 3. Have a current DCSI Clearance (Dept of Communities and Social Inclusion) Working With Children
- 4. Develop and Promote Netball in line with MHNA "Our Values" statement.
- 5. Ensure the environment encourages and develops players skills.
- 6. Encourage Team comradeship between members of Rep teams and all personnel.
- 7. Provide written notice to advise players, families, and officials the dates of carnivals to be attended as soon as possible. Have an avenue of communication with the team as a group following the guidelines of the social media Policy.
- 8. Advise the Carnival Registration Coordinator as soon as possible, which carnivals to be attended and the grade of team participating.
- 9. Country Championships and Mid Hills Carnivals are compulsory for all teams that have a programmed competition in the relevant age group. The Carnival Committee (Chairperson or Secretary) must be notified immediately of any player who is unable to attend the compulsory carnivals. (extenuating circumstances can have application made via letter to committee)
- 10. Attend all scheduled training and carnivals, unless due to injury, illness or other valid reason and communicate this to the Coaching Team
- 11. Endeavour to allocate players equal court time over the duration of the carnival season minor rounds. The aim of the representative side is to give all team members as much experience at this level as possible, therefore raising their skill level. Keeping written/ retrievable records in case of discrepancies.
- 12. Ensure a report is submitted following each carnival attended to the Courier Newspaper by the first Friday after each carnival.
- 13. Submit a report to each Carnival Committee meeting. The report is to include team performance and individual player issues etc .
- 14. Attend, if possible regular Carnival Committee meetings and co-operate and work with committee decisions.



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- 15. Attend the Mid Hills Association Rep Team presentation if held.
- 16. Full Uniform as approved by the Mid Hills Association to be worn whilst attending carnivals and official events. The Uniform is to be maintained in a clean and well-maintained condition.
- 17. No smoking, vaping, or taking or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances is permitted by any official or team member in any Official Netball Area.
- 18. In the event of an overnight stay two adults (with DCSI clearance) must be in attendance in case an emergency arises.
- 19. Support fundraising activities on behalf of the Representative Team/s
